General Information

What are the event dates? Jan. 23-25 but you can book to arrive as early as Thur, Jan. 22nd.

How much does it cost to attend? Event Passes are \$75 per person for Friday - Sunday, any days before is an extra \$35 per person per day. If you buy your passes when you arrive to the campground, they will be \$100 per pass. *(You will check-in at the event using the QR Code that was sent to your email after purchase.)

What does the price include? Event Passes include tent camping for Friday & Saturday nights, use of all the campground's amenities, and all the fun each day & night! *(RV Sites and Cabins have different price points but all include Events Passes for Fri & Sat for 2 people.)

Where is the event located? The event will be held at Mountain Breeze Campground in New Braunfels, TX.

What is the address of the event? 9250 River Rd, New Braunfels, TX 78132

Who may attend the event? Couples and single females are always welcome but single males must be accompanied by a female date or be sponsored by an attending couple.

Why do we have to RSVP on the KOS website? People like to see who is going and where there from. It's also a great way for people to connect before the trip! The event is listed on many social platforms and LS websites.

Is there a "Day Pass" to buy if we are staying offsite? This event does not offer a "Day Pass" everyone attending must purchase an Event Pass weather staying at Mountain Breeze or offsite.

What activities will there be on the trip? There is always something happening day and night! Check out the website and weekend line up for details!

Is nudity allowed in the campground? This event is during the off season of the campground so nudity will not be a problem within the general area campground, but please be aware nudity is not permitted in areas visible from the public roads and water ways surrounding Mountain Breeze Campgroup.

Can we have sex in the open? This is a little tricky...yes but please use common sense and stay away from areas visible to the public outside of the campground.

Are single males allowed to attend? Single males are only allowed to attend with a date or with a sponsored couple. If with a date they are to conduct themselves and will be treated like any other couple. If he is sponsored by a couple, he is the responsibility of that couple for the weekend and if he is asked to leave, they in turn will be too. So, couples be warned... Also, the sponsoring couple must contact us ahead of time with the name of the single male they will be sponsoring. Couples can only sponsor one single male.

What is the refund policy if we have to cancel? There are no refunds, but we do offer event insurance when you book online.

Camping Information

Do we need to call Mountain Breeze Campground to reserve a spot to tent camp? No. The entire campground has already been reserved for our group.

How do I know what campsite in the campground is mine? The tent camping area is first come first pick. We do not reserve an area for each person and do not go by Mountain Breeze's campsite map. Basically, when you arrive you pick an area that's to your liking and available then set up your camp.

Is there electricity and water for tents? There are shared electrical outlets throughout the tent camping area but no water. There are a few water outlets in throughout the campground but just not at every site.

Can you run an electric heater in your tent? We strongly discourage the use of electric heaters in the tent camping areas (propane Buddy Heater style heaters are preferred). The circuits really can't handle the load. This also includes fridges, or freezers of any kind (lights, fans, radios are ok). If we start blowing breakers and one of those items are found, everyone on that circuit will be asked to remove them and store them in your vehicle for the remainder of the trip. You can use a small whisper quiet inverter style generator like a Honda that cannot be heard from 15 foot away in the tent camping area.

Can I hold a spot next to me for a friend? You can only hold a spot for a friend if you have the friends' tent (NOT A POP UP) and set it up for them before they arrive.

How big are the tent sites? Tent camping space is not determined by the Mountain Breeze camping site map on their website. Traditionally we can get 3-4 tents per site. This way we maximize the space to accommodate everyone. We prefer to limit every couple to one tent and one popup (20'X20' Area).

We are bringing an RV how do we reserve a site? All RV sites can be reserved on our website.

Is there full hook up RV sites? Yes. We have 30 Amp & 50 Amp with electricity and water hook ups (Book Full Hook Up with sewer @ Soggy Dollar campground), along with self-contained sites (generator needed).

Can we park our RV where ever we want when we arrive? No. A KOS staff member will point you to your spot. *(In Self-Contained RV camping mostly, we begin at one end of the field and fill in the next hole as everyone arrives.)

Are there cabins available to rent? Yes! Cabins feature at a minimum a full-size bed, AC unit, picnic table, and fire pit. Some have more amenities. *(You will need to provide your own small electric heater to heat the cabin.)

Are there any cabins or hotels nearby? There aren't any hotels very close but there are places nearby that rent cabins. Click on Offsite Lodging on the trip's web page. But no matter where you stay off site Uber is available to you.

Last year there was a company that rented tents and set them up before you arrived. Will that be available again this year? Yes!... Go to the trip's Bookings web page.

Are dogs allowed at the campground? Only official ADA Service dogs are allowed at Mountain Breeze Campground per the owners' request. Dogs are allowed at Soggy Dollar Campground next door.

Are golf carts allowed at the campground? Yes...Golf carts and mules are only allowed. SXS, 4 wheelers, dirt bikes, and mini bikes are NOT!
